<b>Carrier Liability Coverage</b>	420-2B	1. All shipments tendered to Carrier will be subject to a maximum liability not exceeding \$2 per pound. 2. When Consignor or Consignee declares a value in excess of \$2 per pound, a charge equal to 2% of the excess value will be added to the otherwise applicable freight charges, subject to a minimum charge of \$43. 3. When Consignor or Consignee tenders to Carrier used or reconditioned articles, Carrier's maximum liability shall be \$0.10 per pound, capped at the total weight of the shipment. No excess liability coverage will be available.
<b>Credit Card Payments</b>	435-2B	3% of total freight and accessorial charges.
<b>Detention</b>	500-2-2B	For detention, the following charges and provisions will apply: \$82 per pup for each 15 minutes or fraction thereof, subject to a minimum charge of \$97.
<b>Exhibition Sites</b>	520-1-2B	\$236 per shipment.
<b>Extreme Length</b>	530	\$775 per shipment, with a dimension of 12 feet or greater and less than 15 feet. \$982 per shipment, with a dimension of 15 feet or greater and less than 18 feet \$1,234 per shipment, with a dimension of 18 feet or greater and less than 20 feet. \$1,514 per shipment, with a dimension of 20 feet or greater.
<b>Hazardous Material Handling</b>	920-1-2B	\$68 per shipment.
<b>Inside Pickup or Delivery</b>	566-1-2B	\$18.92 per cwt subject to a minimum charge of \$200 per shipment.
<b>Liftgate Service</b>	890-1-2B	\$207
<b>Limited Access Pickup or Delivery</b>	750-8-2B	\$229 per shipment. Limited access includes but is not limited to individual (mini) storage units, churches, schools, commercial establishments not open to the walk-in public during normal business hours, construction sites, fairs or carnivals, prisons, military base/installations, rural route or out of town highway access locations, businesses located in residential areas in Canada, and sites requiring security inspections prior to delivery.
<b>Non-Business Time or Non-Business Days</b> See FXF 100 Series Rules Tariff for service outside of the Service Centre Metro area.	753-2B	A. Straight truck less than 24 feet (7.32 metres) in length or vehicle with trailer of less than 29 feet (8.84 metres) in length — \$228 per person per hour or fraction thereof subject to minimum charge of \$837 minimum charge per person. B. Vehicle of greater length than above or if shipment exceeds 12 skid spaces — \$269 per person per hour or fraction thereof, subject to minimum charge of \$1,174 minimum charge per person.
<b>Notification Prior to Delivery</b>	750-3-2B	\$69 per shipment.
<b>Over Length</b>	525	\$375 per shipment when containing any handling unit with a dimension of 8 feet (2.44 metres) or greater in length and less than 12 feet (3.66 metres) in length.
<b>Redelivery</b>	830-2B	\$21.05 per cwt subject to a minimum charge of \$210 min charge and a maximum charge of \$2,203 max charge.
<b>Regional Shopping Malls</b>	750-9-2B	\$61 per shipment.
<b>Residential Pickup or Delivery</b>	750-2-2B	\$243 per shipment.
<b>Storage — When Freight is Held by Carrier</b> See the FXF 100 Series Rules Tariff for more information and additional charges.	910	1. \$6.03 per cwt per each 24 hours, subject to the following minimum and maximum charges: A. Minimum charge, LTL, \$59 per shipment per each 24 hours, but not less than \$210 per shipment. B. Minimum charge, TL, Volume, Exclusive Use or Capacity Load, \$419 per shipment. C. Maximum charge, LTL and/or TL, or per pup if more than one pup or if a vehicle is used: \$419 for the first 24 hours or fraction thereof. \$561 for the second 24 hours or fraction thereof. \$842 for the third and each succeeding 24 hours or fraction thereof.

<b>Weight</b> (Reweigh)	981	<p>If scaled weight is 50 lbs. (22.68 kg) more or 200 lbs. (90.72 kg) less than the weight on Bill of Lading a reweigh fee of \$40 applies plus all applicable freight, fuel surcharge and accessorial will be modified accordingly.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In the event Carrier reweighs the shipment and the difference in weight is less than 50 pounds greater than the weight on the Bill of Lading, no reweigh fee applies and no changes in linehaul charges will occur.</li> <li>2. In the event Carrier validates the weight of the shipment and the difference in weight is an increase of 50 pounds or greater than the weight on the Bill of Lading, a validation fee of \$40 applies, plus all applicable freight, fuel surcharge, and optional and additional service fees and charges will be modified accordingly.</li> <li>3. In the event Carrier validates the weight of the shipment and the difference in weight is a reduction of 200 pounds or more than the weight on the Bill of Lading, a validation fee of \$40 applies, plus all applicable freight, fuel surcharge, and optional and additional service fees and charges will be modified accordingly.</li> <li>4. A freight validation fee of \$40 per occurrence will be applied to any freight bill where an adjustment to linehaul and/or optional and additional service fees and charges has been made due to an inspection. This charge will be in addition to all other lawful charges.</li> <li>5. In the event that a shipment is reweighed subject to paragraphs 2 or 3 within Item 981 and/or inspected subject to paragraph 4 within Item 981, Carrier will apply only one validation fee of \$40 to a shipment.</li> <li>6. A validation fee will not apply to: A. A shipment subject to CCD as found in Item 613 or Item 614 within this rules tariff. B.
